Different Filming Angles

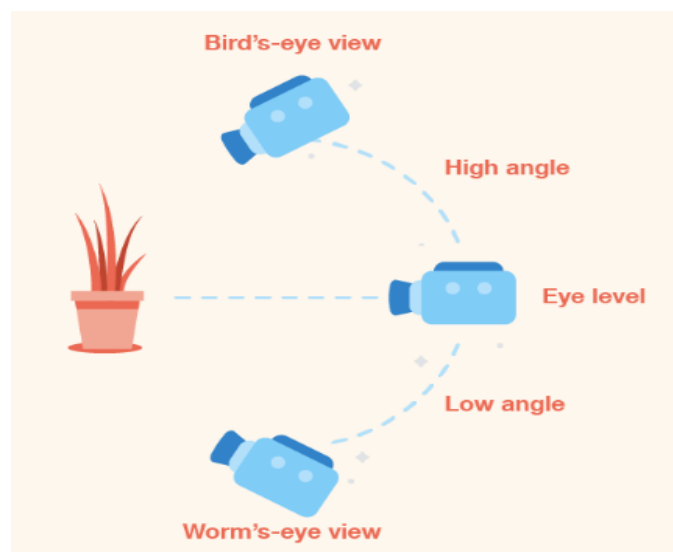
Low angle: where the camera is below eye-level and points upwards toward the subject.

High angle: where the camera is higher than eye-level, shooting down from above.

Side angles: a **shot** from the side or behind.

Bird's-eye view or worm's-eye view: looking down from directly above or up from the ground.

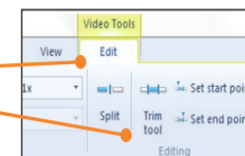
Experiment with angles to get the best shot!



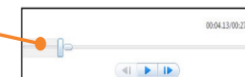
Consistency is key!

Keep the themes across your video **similar**. Having a **natural transition** between clips/frames **helps** to get your **message** or **information** across **efficiently**.

To bring any unwanted frames out of your film clips, click on **Edit** and then **Trim tool**.



Use the sliders at each end to trim the video clip.



Click **Save Trim** when you are finished.

Post-production

Review your work after filming and begin editing clips using video editor tools. Clips and images can appear different when looked at from a different perspective. Analyse your video to see if your creation meets the needs of the audience and executes your vision.
