

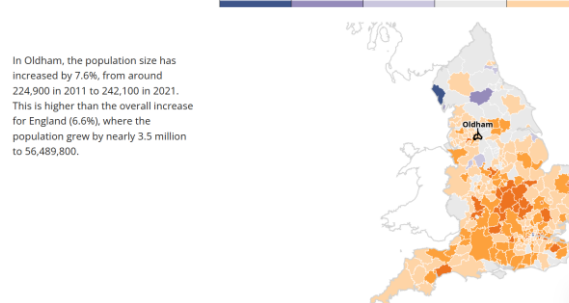


Year 3 Geography Knowledge Organiser Topic- What do we know about the United Kingdom?

Key Vocabulary

Physical features	In geography, physical features are natural elements and landforms of the Earth's surface, like mountains, rivers, and forests, that are not created by humans.
Human features	In geography, a human feature is something created or altered by humans, unlike physical features which are naturally occurring.
population	All the inhabitants of a particular place.
migration	Migration, in the context of people, refers to the movement of individuals from one place to another, either temporarily or permanently.
