Keyword	Definition
cyber-bullying	Using electronic communications to send violent, threatening, or harmful messages to someone.
E-safe	Being safe on the internet.
password	A set of characters and symbols known only by the user to keep their information safe online.
protection	Programmes or software designed to protect the device from threats and viruses.
responsibility	Having a duty to control or look after something.
secure	To remain safe and out of danger.

S **Stay Safe**
Don't give out your personal information to people / places you don't know.

M **Don't Meet Up**
Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust.

A **Accepting Files**
Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.

R **Reliable?**
Check information before you believe it. Is the person or website telling the truth?

T **Tell Someone**
Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.

Follow these SMART tips to keep yourself safe online!

HOW TO SPOT FAKE NEWS

CONSIDER THE SOURCE
Click away from the story to investigate the site, its mission and its contact info.

READ BEYOND
Headlines can be outrageous in an effort to get clicks. What's the whole story?

CHECK THE AUTHOR
Do a quick search on the author. Are they credible? Are they real?

SUPPORTING SOURCES?
Click on those links. Determine if the info given actually supports the story.

CHECK THE DATE
Reposting old news stories doesn't mean they're relevant to current events.

IS IT A JOKE?
If it is too outlandish, it might be satire. Research the site and author to be sure.

When in doubt, don't share!

Careful what you click!

Many webpages and applications include ads or links which users often click on. Clicking on them could be **harmful** to your device as they could include a **computer virus** or code which could **access** all the **private information** on your device. Always **ask an adult** before clicking on something you're unsure of.

Communicating online

Online communication is great for staying in touch with friends and family. Always **be kind** towards others and think about their feelings. If you **don't like** what someone has **said or sent**, **tell an adult**. If you **see it** happening to others, **advise them** on what to do.
