

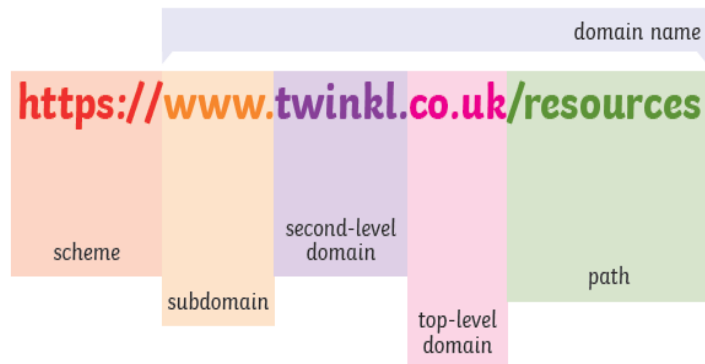


Key Vocabulary

Keyword	Definition
internet	A vast network of computers connected to each other all around the world.
ranking	The position of something in an order.
Unique Resource Locator (url)	The address of a webpage. Similar to the addresses of houses, websites have addresses and their location on the internet.
validity	The quality of being correct or true.
Web browser	A web browser allows you to access the internet, including search engines and other web pages
Website	A set of web pages grouped together in one place,

Parts of the URL

A **web pages's** **URL** is located in the address bar.



- **Scheme** – The part that specifies the type of application your device uses to open a URL.
- **Subdomain** – The part that allows websites to separate and organize content.
- **Second-level domain** – This comes before the top-level domain and is mainly the website's name. This is why it's the 'core' of the brand.
- **Top-level domain** – Recognise certain elements of a website such as its purpose, owner or geographical area.
- **Path** – Refers to the exact location of a page, post, file or other asset.

Search Engine

A search engine is a service you use on the **Internet** to help you find information via the World Wide Web.

They allow us to input words or phrases into the search bar or address bar. The search engine then provides a list of **websites** or **web pages** that link to the words or phrases that were inputted.



Each search engine's results page will look different. The results of a search is displayed based on a page ranking computer program and the user's search vocabulary. Remember to be specific!
