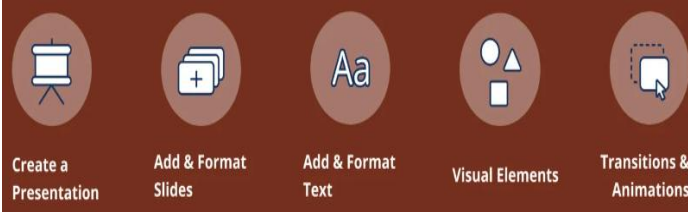




Key Vocabulary

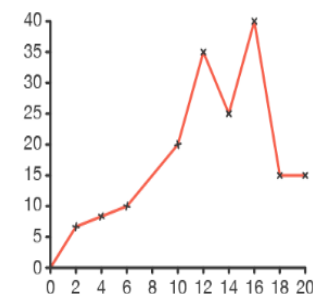

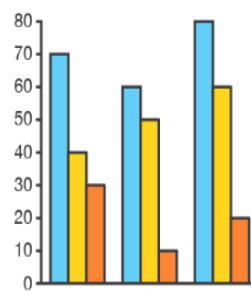
pie chart



line graph



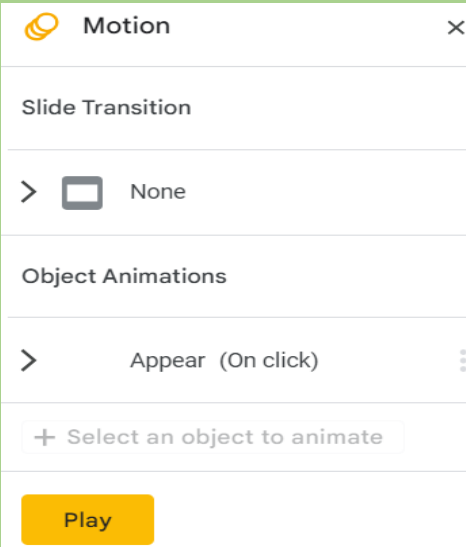
