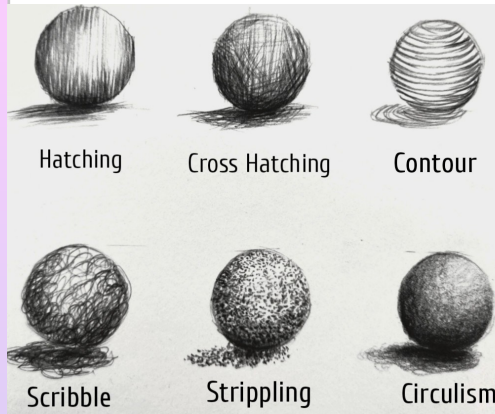

Shading/Tone

Shading adds value to create an illusion of form, space and light. Using graphite pencils from hard (H) or HB to soft (B) will give a distinctive look. The 2B pencils are great for medium or light shading but for darker shading use 4B pencil or an even darker shade 6B to show definition.

Sketching

Sketching is drawing freehand and intended as a rough draft. This allows the artist the freedom to sketch the outlines.

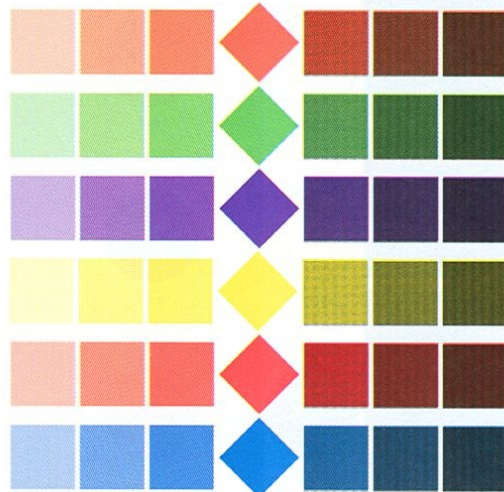
Colours

We know red, yellow and blue are primary colours.

Orange, green, purple are the secondary colours.

These colours can be altered to show depth, form, space and light captured in an artwork.

Tints vs. Shades



Tint: A hue's lighter value, created by adding white

Shade: A hue's darker value, created by adding black

Landscape Art

Landscape Art is a depiction of natural scenery such as mountains, parks, valleys, trees, rivers, desert, beaches, fields and buildings.

This genre is categorized in three elements.

1. Representational art stems from something with strong reference to the real world.
2. Impressionistic art is an open composition with an emphasis on light in its changing quality.
3. Abstract art does not attempt to depict reality.
