School jumpers and t-shirts can be bought from Debonair. All other uniform items can be purchased from any uniform supplier or supermarkets



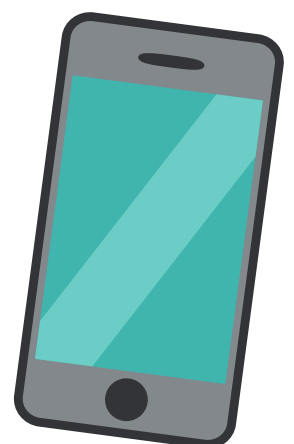
School Dinners
